### **Cloakroom area**

We are having a big initiative after half-term to improve the outdoor areas outside Foxes and Badgers classes. ### **School Gates**

As part of our responsibility for keeping our children safe in school, we are going to keep the school gates closed during the school day after half-term. As you will probably already know, the gates are currently padlocked at break times and lunchtimes and they are unlocked at other times to enable visitors to access the school via the school office. After half-term, each gate will have a chain link that will keep the gate closed but will enable visitors to unwrap the link and enter the school ground. If you come into school during the day, please will you put the link in place when you come in and when you leave the premises. This measure has been taken to ensure that our children are safe and that the school grounds are secure during any part of the school day.
