Covid update - We are now in Tier 2

- You must keep a 2m distance from staff at the doors, do ring the school or send an email if you need to communicate with the class teacher.
- Remember to contact us even if it is a weekend or evening on the office email if you need to inform us if anyone in your household is experiencing symptoms and going for a test or if your family have been in close contact with a positive case and you need to self-isolate.
- Thank you to everyone for wearing masks on the site to protect families and staff we do have people who are vulnerable so it is really important.
- We are ventilating rooms as much as possible so please make sure your child is dressed warmly, vests may be necessary.
