NHS charities together—The council referred to the strikes and how much the hospitals needed support when they chose this one.

All the charities are very worthy causes which made it very difficult. Following the class votes we can say on this occasion they voted to raise money to sponsor a guide dog. Just £104 sponsors a guide dog puppy for 2 years.

On Tuesday the 21st February, "Shrove Tuesday" we will not just be thinking about what we shall give up for lent but instead what we can give to others by raising money to sponsor a guide dog.


