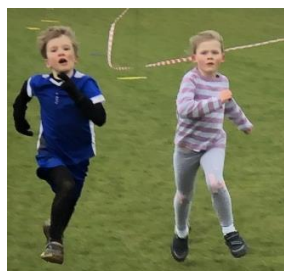


## Amazing News!

## Molly's story



Hi, I am Molly, I am 7. I wrote to Mrs Stevens to ask if we could raise money for epilepsy awareness on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2020. We were going to do a cake sale but we can't do this at the moment so we can raise awareness instead. This is my story. I was six when I got it, I was in my Mum and Dad's bed when it happened. My Mummy called the hospital and I went in an ambulance with my Mummy. When I got to hospital we waited on chairs then we went in a room with a doctor and my Mummy and then I went in a bed at the hospital and I stayed for three weeks. The doctor gave me lots of tests and medicine but one of the tests went wrong and gave me a rash. Finally I went out of hospital I was excited. I now take a medicine called Tegretol every day. That is my life with epilepsy and why I would like to fundraise.
