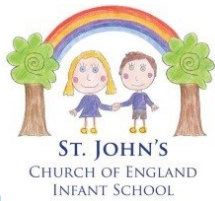

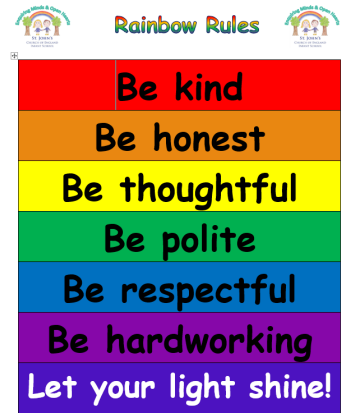


"Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God"



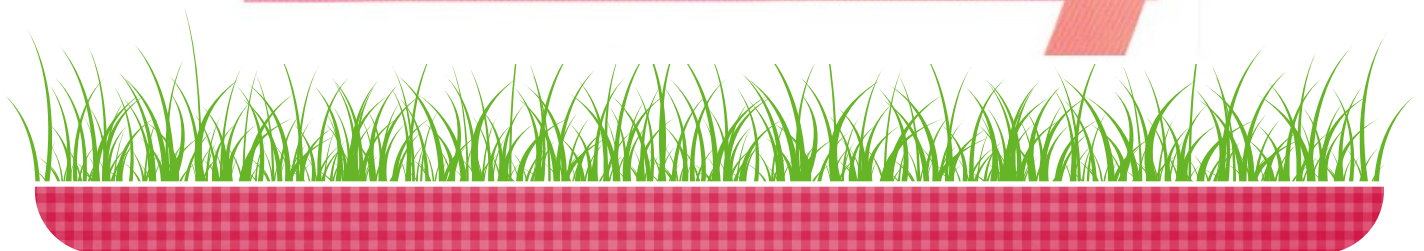

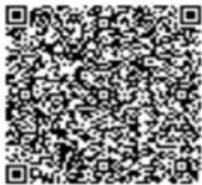
