Thank you so much for your efforts so far, we do already have a mixture of illnesses appearing and are grateful for your vigilance and swift actions.

If your child or anyone in your household is experiencing symptoms of COVID then you must stay at home, seek advice from 111 and obtain a test. We know there is currently difficulty in obtaining tests so the advice remains the same. <u>Until you receive a test and the result, the household must isolate - the patient isolates for at least 10 days</u> but it is 14 days for all other household members.

If test availability is causing you difficulty, we may be able to offer a home testing kit for the child attending our school. This is not advised as the best way of obtaining a test it takes much longer to get the results, so test centres are preferable.

We do now have a dedicated COVID page on the school website where you will find the relevant policies, useful links and documents.

Please may I remind all adults to remain at a physical distance from each other. Some people are at greater risk and need us all to help keep them safe. If you wish to wear a mask on site then please do, children have adapted to seeing them worn now.
