Dear Parents,

Welcome back to our final term of the year. As always we will be at our busiest, particularly this half-term with such a short time to fit everything in! Please can you help us by making sure that your children arrive with sunscreen already applied, equipped with a sunhat and a bottle of water to keep them hydrated when the forecast is predicting a sunny day - We would really like to be a 'Sun-safe' school so it would be great if you could support us by doing this.

It will not be long before our Year 2 children are taking part in their 'fun quizzes' (SATs or Statutory Assessment Tests) as May is the month assigned for this. Please can all parents be aware of this and make sure they are well rested and able to do their very best. These are only one part of the evidence that we use to assess them but we want to make sure they manage to show us all that they can do.

You will shortly be receiving your topic curriculum letters for this half-term.

In our PSHE lessons this term, we will be discussing the NSPCC's PANTS rules. These are designed to teach pupils how to stay safe from sexual abuse, without giving explicit information or telling scary stories or even using the term "sexual abuse". In the lesson, children will learn about the 'PANTS' acrostic, which stands for:

- · Privates are private.
- · Always remember your body belongs to you.
- \cdot No means no \cdot Talk about secrets that upset you
- Speak up, someone can help. The lesson will be fully age-appropriate.
