Watch my video introduction on understanding the terms heavier and lighter. Picking two objects and holding one in each hand can you say which item you think is heavier and which is lighter?	Watch my video introduction on Purple mash looking at scales and saying which objects are heavier and which are lighter. With a hanger and a bag on each end to act as your scales place an object in each bag and label which is heavier and which is lighter.	Watch my video introduction on Purple mash about understanding how heavy something is using a non-standard measure. With your hanger scales and an item such as potatoes or carrots to act as your measure. Weigh different items recording how many of your weights it takes to balance the scales. Use can use the grid on purple mash to record your findings if you wish.	Watch my video introduction on purple mash about saying which objects are heavier or lighter based on how much they weigh. Then weigh some different objects like you did yesterday and record how much they weigh. Choose 2 different objects from the ones you have weighed and say which item is heavier and which is lighter.	Watch my video introduction about ordering the objects from lightest to heaviest. Then weigh some more objects. Once you have at least 5 objects can you put them in order from lightest to heaviest.
