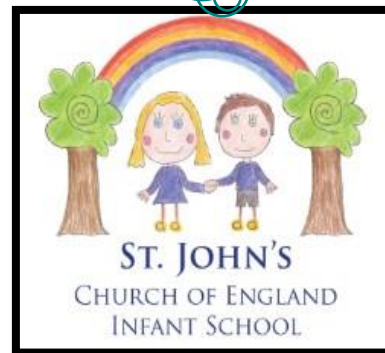

What makes a good story?



English

We will start this half term with the story of The Day the Crayons came home and looking at letter writing in preparation for our Big Write event. We will then progress onto looking at the Wolf's untold story of The 3 little pigs and writing newspaper reports about this.

Mathematics

This half term we will be starting off with recapping over some place value skills and adding in some new knowledge as well as incorporating other skills within place value. We will the progress onto learning about measuring length and height and the language used in relation to this.

Science

Within Science the children will be looking at different materials and their suitability for a particular purpose. We will be carrying out an investigation in relation to the houses of The 3 little pigs.

RE

In R.E we will be looking at various Biblical stories such as Joseph and the Technicolour Dreamcoat and also looking at quotes from the Bible to explore what these might mean. We will compare Christian's belief of Forgiveness to that of the Jewish before thinking about Easter towards the end of term.

PE

During our outdoor Monday PE lessons we will be continuing with our learning the skills of football with an experienced coach. During our indoor Friday PE lessons the children will be taking part in various team games to help with team building and starting to use tactics.

PSHE

PSHE will be taught alongside many other subjects and worked seamlessly into everyday lessons so the children can see that various social skills are needed everywhere, we will especially be looking at taking other people's perspectives of situations with the untold Wolf's version of the 3 little pigs.

Geography/History

As part of Geography we will learning about maps, why they are used. We will be completing maps to help Duncan find his crayons from the book, The day the crayons came home.

Art/DT

In Art the children will be learning about sculptures. We will be learning how to manipulate clay to then progress onto creating sculptures. They will then think about what inspired them.

Music/Computing

As part of music the children will be learning about how to make music with various parts of their bodies.
