English

Mathematics

This term we will focus on number bonds to 10 and 20, counting and place value. We will also be ordering and comparing numbers using greater than, less than and equal signs. As well as Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's!

RE

During RE this term the children will be discussing the question: Why is the bible an important book? Focusing on books in the bible, how it helps people and what part it plays in the lives of children and their families.

Science

In science the children will be exploring every day materials as well as making shelters and carrying out experiments. We will be learning to evaluate our findings.

PE

Within PE we will be covering basic movements such as balancing and jumping before then using these to incorporate into our own dance compositions. We will also be taking part in cosmic yoga classes and outdoor team games.

PSHE

Our focus upon return to school will be understanding and managing our feelings. We will also be observing anti-bullying week and taking part in 'odd socks day' to mark this.

Geography/History

We will be learning about the continents and oceans of the world as well as geographical features. In history we will be looking at the invention of light and the story of Guy Fawkes.

Art/DT

In art we will be learning about a chosen artist and how to use paints and pastels to create a picture in the same style.

Music/Computing

Within music we are going to be exploring music from Africa and the Caribbean during black history month as well as learning to play a familiar song. In ICT we will be focusing on E safety and word processing.
