Topic: Walking with Dinosaurs

Big question: Who was here before us?



Mathematics

Our topic for Mathematics this half term is multiplication and division. We will learn to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables, including recognising odd and even numbers. We will be able to solve problems involving multiplication and division, by using materials, arrays, mental methods, repeated addition and multiplication and division facts, including problems in contexts.

Role Play:
Archaeologists

English

Our focus for English this half term will be to consider the use of past and present tense in our writing. Recording real events simply and clearly using knowledge gained from research..

RE

This half term we will be answering the question: What is a Christian? We will look at what the bible tells us about Christians and their beliefs. We will also find out what Easter is about and what it means to Christians.

Science

In Science this half term we will be investigating materials and where they come from. We will be carrying out a series of experiments to separate man-made and natural materials.

PE

We will begin our football lessons on a Monday afternoon, focusing on ball control, team work and learning the rules of the beautiful game! We will be continuing to follow a story through movement during our indoor dance lessons.

PSHE

We will focus on emotions and Behaviour-recognise different types of teasing and bullying, to understand that these are wrong and unacceptable. Look at and discuss strategies to resist teasing or bullying.

Geography/History

Walking with Dinosaurs. We will be learning fun and interesting facts about dinosaurs as well as carrying out our own research and presenting a non-chronological report on dinosaurs.

Art/DT

We will be learning about an artist, craft maker and designer. Looking at the history of an illustrator, Quentin Blake. Using mechanisms, levers, sliders and wheels. Making a pop up Easter card!

Music/Computing

During Computing the children will use the internet to research our topic. As part of our Christian celebrations, the children will be learning songs and singing as part of our Easter service
