

## Mathematics

Children will be looking at measure of length, mass, capacity and temperature. They will also use their knowledge of the four operations to solve measure problems. They will also learn about position and direction and recap on shape. Children will also use their mathematical skills to solve problems.

## PSHE

We will be discussing the children's journey throughout St John's. They will begin to think about their next journey in their new school as they transition into Yr 3. We will discuss their feelings towards their next school and how to deal with these feelings.

## English

Children will be writing about true events such as a recount from their school trip to Brooklands Museum. They will also create their own story based on a character's journey. They will write a non-fiction text based on Christopher Columbus.

## Science

In science the children will be developing their scientific skills by asking enquiring questions, planning experiments and carrying out fair tests.

## PE

Children will be learning country dancing during indoor PE. During outdoor PE children will be learning how to Maypole dance.

## D&T / Art

Children will create a piece of art based on one of Christopher Nevinson's paintings. Our art will be focussed on cars.
